LATUDA (lurasidone oral tablet)

POLICY

I. INDICATIONS

The FDA-approved indications below are considered a covered benefit provided that all the approval criteria are met and the member has no exclusions to the prescribed therapy.

FDA-Approved Indication

Schizophrenia

Latuda is indicated for the treatment of schizophrenia.

Bipolar Disorder, Depressed Phase (Bipolar Depression)

Latuda is indicated as monotherapy and as adjunctive therapy with lithium or valproate for the treatment of depressive episodes associated with Bipolar I Disorder.

All other indications are considered experimental/investigational and are not a covered benefit.

II. CRITERIA FOR APPROVAL

A. Schizophrenia

An authorization may be granted for 12 months when the following criteria (1) and (2) are met:

- 1. The patient experienced an inadequate treatment response after a trial of at least 30 days, intolerance, or contraindication to three generic atypical antipsychotics
- 2. The requested drug is being prescribed for the treatment of schizophrenia

B. Bipolar Disorder, Depressed Phase (Bipolar Depression)

An authorization may be granted for 12 months when the following criteria (1) and (2) are met:

- 1. The patient experienced an inadequate treatment response after a trial of at least 60 days or intolerance to two generic atypical antipsychotics
- 2. The requested drug is being prescribed for the treatment of depressive episodes associated with Bipolar I disorder

III. QUANTITY LIMIT

Latuda 20mg, 40mg, 60mg, 120mg tablet have a quantity limit of 1 tablet per day, and Latuda 80mg tablet has a quantity limit of 2 tablets per day.
