The following changes to the Neighborhood Medicaid Formulary were recently approved by the Pharmacy and Therapeutics (P&T) Committee or a recent generic became available for a formulary medication. All changes to the formulary are effective immediately unless otherwise noted.

Methylphenidate solution	Pharmacy Benefit	Added to the Formulary with a Prior Authorization
Methylphenidate chewable tablets	Pharmacy Benefit	Added to the Formulary a Prior Authorization and Quantity Limit
Chenodal	Pharmacy Benefit	Added to the Formulary with a Prior Authorization
Chemet	Pharmacy Benefit	Added to the Formulary with a Prior Authorization
Kerendia	Pharmacy Benefit	Added to the Formulary with a Prior Authorization and Quantity Limit
Scemblix	Pharmacy Benefit	Added to the Formulary with a Prior Authorization and Quantity Limit
Besremi	Pharmacy Benefit	Added to the Formulary with a Prior Authorization and Quantity Limit
