### New Documentation Requirements for Plastic Surgery Procedures

# Q: What is the purpose of this notification?

**A:** Effective **July 1, 2024**, Neighborhood is implementing new documentation requirements for preapproval of <u>panniculectomies</u> and breast reduction procedures. This is a medical cost action initiative intended to confirm the medical necessity of these procedures.

#### Q: What new documentation will be required?

**A:** Newly required documentation includes office notes on treatments and outcomes, chronic conditions, and medication history.

# Q: What procedures are affected by these new requirements?

**A:** The new documentation requirements only apply to panniculectomies and breast reductions to treat hypertrophy in females and gynecomastia in males.

# Q: Do these requirements apply to all lines of business?

**A:** Yes, these requirements apply to all Neighborhood lines of business.

# Q: Where can providers find more information on the criteria Neighborhood follows for these procedures?

**A:** Providers can refer to the <u>Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS)</u> and the <u>Rhode Island Executive Office of Health and Human Services</u> for additional information.
