

Upcoming Medicaid Pharmacy Benefit Changes

Neighborhood News – October 2024

Effective **October 1, 2024**, Neighborhood Health Plan of Rhode Island will implement changes to our Medicaid Pharmacy Formulary:

- **Basaglar** and **Semglee** will be removed from the Medicaid Formulary.
- **Insulin Glargine-YFGN**, **Lantus** and **Rezvoglar** will be the preferred long-acting insulin products.

Medicaid members currently using **Basaglar & Semglee** products will need to obtain a new prescription for one of the preferred insulin products. It's important for providers to begin transitioning affected patients to ensure continuous care.

Please note, there will be no changes to the coverage of short-acting insulins under this update.

Note: These formulary changes are applicable only to Medicaid members and do not affect Commercial or INTEGRITY (MMP) members.
