#### SUMMARY OF THE FILING

Neighborhood Health Plan of Rhode Island is a non-profit health maintenance organization which provides individual insurance through HealthSource R.I., the State of Rhode Island's health benefits exchange. Neighborhood also provides insurance for Small Businesses, Medicaid recipients and dual eligible Medicaid-Medicare recipients, but this filing deals only with individual insurance rates and not any other insurance programs.

Neighborhood is seeking approval of new rates for its Individual Market Products and new rates would be effective for the 2026 calendar year beginning January 1, 2026.

The new rates are being sought because of projected increases in medical and pharmacy claims among the population of Neighborhood members with individual insurance, as well as increases for risk transfer payments and state mandated increases to providers and other state programs known at the time of submission. In addition, the anticipated loss of certain federal premium tax credits needs to be considered in efforts to maintain the proper financial condition and mission of Neighborhood. The rate increases sought by Neighborhood range from approximately 20.1% to 22.2% over the current rates, depending on the specific plan and not including any applicable increase due to a change in age. Neighborhood's proposed overall average rate increase of approximately 21.2%, not inclusive of any applicable increase due to a change in age.
